Hi I am Barbara Francis the new President of the Honor HER Foundation Inc. As I reflect over the past year, I am extremely grateful for what we accomplished. As COVID-19 raged across the country and we saw our local number of infections rise across Northwest Florida, we continued to function. Not only function, but we were the only place still accepting residents into our Faith House.

Like other non-profits, our donations slowed as the economy shuttered and we canceled several of our charity events due to the rise of COVID infections. But with your support, our family, we were able to thrive. At the end of the year we were able to introduce to the Northwest Florida community our inaugural All Services Ball which raised monies for Faith House and allowed us to give back to other community organizations. We held Season 2 of our We See You: Women Veterans Photo exhibit with an additional 60 portraits being added. We also provided housing to 11 women veterans, during the pandemic; 4 have found permanent housing and 3 found employment. Though with every success comes the heartbreaking task of not being able to help everyone who sought housing.

The need for Faith House is evident. There are many women veterans that still struggle with housing, mental health crisis, joblessness. We offer a beacon of hope through our many services and home. It is because of your donations and continued support that we are able to take care of our sisters in arms.



Our Mission
